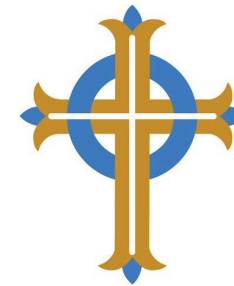

The popular weekly service, the Pilgrim's Mass, focuses on seeing our lives as a journey. The Revs. Jeff Bunke and John Hagan, local Episcopal priests, celebrate the Eucharist and focus the sermons on the saint remembered that day. The worship uses prayers whose goal is to focus on the direction of our lives and how God feeds and strengthens us as we move through each moment and each day.

All are welcome and accepted, to this communion service, as the worship provides bread for the journey of our individual pilgrimages.

**Sunday Christian Education**
